




## Average Occupancy Statistics Air Rights Comparison of 2017 through 2020 Facility Capacity 2552






## **Average Occupancy Statistics Union Station** Comparison of 2017 through 2020 **Facility Capacity 1133**






## **Average Occupancy Statistics Crown** Comparison of 2017 through 2020 **Facility Capacity 708**






## Average Occupancy Statistics State/Wall Comparison of 2017 through 2020 **Facility Capacity 120**






## **Average Occupancy Statistics Temple Medical** Comparison of 2017 through 2020 **Facility Capacity 371**





## All units combined - weekday distribution




## All units combined - hourly distribution
