




Average Occupancy Statistics Air Rights Comparison of 2017 through 2020 Facility Capacity 2552






Average Occupancy Statistics Union Station Comparison of 2017 through 2020 **Facility Capacity 1133**






Average Occupancy Statistics Crown Facility Capacity 708






Average Occupancy Statistics Granite Square Facility Capacity 305 Upper and Lower Comparison of 2017 through 2020






Average Occupancy Statistics State/Wall Comparison of 2017 through 2020 **Facility Capacity 120**






Average Occupancy Statistics Temple Medical Comparison of 2017 through 2020 **Facility Capacity 371**





All units combined - weekday distribution




All units combined - hourly distribution
