





Average Occupancy Statistics Air Rights Comparison of 2019 through 2021 Facility Capacity 2552







Average Occupancy Statistics Union Station Comparison of 2019 through 2021 **Facility Capacity 1133**




Average Occupancy Statistics Crown Facility Capacity 708



Average Occupancy Statistics Granite Square Facility Capacity 305 Upper and Lower Comparison of 2019 through 2021




Average Occupancy Statistics Orange & Facility Capacity 30 Comparison of 2019 through 2021




Average Occupancy Statistics State/Wall Comparison of 2019 through 2021 Facility Capacity 120






Average Occupancy Statistics Temple Medical Comparison of 2019 through 2021 **Facility Capacity 371**
