




## Average Occupancy Statistics Air Rights Comparison of 2019 through 2021 Facility Capacity 2552




## Average Occupancy Statistics Union Station Comparison of 2019 through 2021 **Facility Capacity 1133**







## **Average Occupancy Statistics Crown** Comparison of 2017 through 2021 Facility Capacity 708



## Average Occupancy Statistics Granite Square Facility Capacity 305 Upper and Lower Comparison of 2019 through 2021




## Average Occupancy Statistics Orange & Elm Comparison of 2019 through 2021 **Facility Capacity 30**




## Average Occupancy Statistics State/Wall Comparison of 2019 through 2021 **Facility Capacity 120**






## **Average Occupancy Statistics Temple Medical** Comparison of 2019 through 2021 **Facility Capacity 371**





## All units combined - weekday distribution




All units combined - hourly distribution
