


# Average Occupancy Statistics 270 State Street Garage Facility Capacity 266







## **Average Occupancy Statistics Crown** Comparison of 2017 through 2021 Facility Capacity 708




# Average Occupancy Statistics Granite Square Facility Capacity 305 Upper and Lower Comparison of 2019 through 2021










## All units combined - weekday distribution




All units combined - hourly distribution
