






Average Occupancy Statistics Crown Comparison of 2017 through 2021 Facility Capacity 708




Average Occupancy Statistics Granite Square Facility Capacity 305 Upper and Lower Comparison of 2019 through 2021




Average Occupancy Statistics Orange & Elm Comparison of 2019 through 2021 Facility Capacity 30




Average Occupancy Statistics State/Wall Comparison of 2019 through 2021 **Facility Capacity 120**




All units combined - daily distribution





All units combined - weekday distribution




All units combined - hourly distribution
